# THE ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA LABOUR CODE (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2011

# No. 8 of 2011

AN ACT to amend the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code, Cap. 27 and for incidental and connected purposes.

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

# 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code (Amendment) Act, 2010 and shall come into operation on a date that the Minister may, by Notice published in the Gazette, appoint.

# 2. Interpretation

In this Act "the principal Act" means the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code, Cap. 27.

#### 3. Amendment of section F3

The principal Act is amended in section F3 by repealing paragraph (g) and substituting the following—

"(g) a national of a Member State who has been granted entry into Antigua and Barbuda in accordance with section 4 or section 5 of the Caribbean Community Skilled Nationals Act, 1997."
