THE ACETATE OF LEAD (PROHIBITION) ACT

ACETATE OF LEAD (PROHIBITION)

(4th April, 1850.)

108/1850.

1. This Act may be cited as the Acetate of Lead (Prohibition) Act. Short title.

2. Any person who shall in the manufacture of sugar for sale or use knowingly use or permit to be used the acetate of lead, shall, upon conviction thereof before a Magistrate, be liable to a penalty not exceeding five thousand dollars, and in default of payment to be imprisoned for any period not exceeding six calendar months. Acetate of lead prohibited in manufacture of sugar under penalty.

3. One moiety of the penalty imposed shall be payable to the informer, who is hereby declared to be a competent witness, and the other moiety shall be payable to the Accountant-General for the use of Antigua and Barbuda. Disposition of penalty.
