ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

No. 27 of 2003

AN ACT to amend the Companies Act, 1995.

[19th February, 2004]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows —

1. This Act may be cited as the Companies (Amendment) Act, 2003. Short title.

2. Section 362 of the Companies Act 1995, is amended as follows — Amendment of section 362 of the principal Act.

- (a) in subsection (1) by deleting the words “within 2 years after commencement date” and substituting the words “by 31st December 2004”; and
- (b) by deleting subsection (2) and substituting the following —

“(2) A fee of four hundred dollars (EC \$400.00) to defray administration costs must be paid to the Registrar in respect of an application and certificate of continuance under this Division.”
