COINAGE (UNITED KINGDOM COINS DEMONETIZATION)

1. This Act may be cited as the Coinage (United Kingdom Coins Demonetization) Act. **Short title.**

2. As from the 1st day of November, 1967, the United Kingdom coins specified in the First Schedule shall not be legal tender in Antigua and Barbuda. **Demonetization of United Kingdom coins.**

3. The Proclamations issued under the Coinage Acts 1870-1946 of the Parliament of the United Kingdom which are specified in the Second Schedule shall be revoked in their application to Antigua and Barbuda as from the 1st day of November, 1967. **Revocation of certain Proclamations.**
