1. This Act may be cited as the Extradition Act. Short title.

All powers vested in and acts authorized or required to be done by a police magistrate or any justice of the peace in relation to the surrender of fugitive criminals in the United Kingdom under the The Extradition Acts, 1870 and 1873 or any Act amending or substituted for those Acts, are hereby **ccsted** in, and may in Antigua and Barbuda be exercised and done by any magistrate or by the Governor-General in relation to the surrender of fugitive criminals under the said **Acts.** Power of magistrates and the Governor-General in relation to extradition of fugitive criminals. ■ ■
