An ACT to amend the Engineers (Registration) Act 1986
(No. 37 of 1986).

[10th June, 1993]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as
follows-

1. This Act may be cited as the Engineers (Registration) Act, 1993. Short title.

2. Section 9 of the Engineers (Registration) Act, 1986 is amended as follows- Amendment of
section 9 (No. 37
of 1986)

(a) by the deletion of "(1)" immediately after section 9;

(b) by the insertion after paragraph (e) a semi-colon and the word "and"; and

(c) by the insertion after paragraph (e) of the following new paragraph-

"@ at least one of the four years of experience-

(i) in the case of persons who otherwise qualified for registration before the first of February 1987 was acquired in Antigua and Barbuda;

(ii) in the case of persons who otherwise qualified for registration after the first of February 1987 was acquired in Antigua and Barbuda under the direct supervision of an engineer duly registered in Antigua and Barbuda."
