**No. 15 of 2017**

**AN ACT** to amend The Evidence (Special Provisions) Act 2009 No. 5 of 2009 in order to confer on officers of the Office of National Drug and Money Laundering Control Policy certain powers already exercisable by the police under the Act.

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows-

**1. Short Title**

This Act may be cited as The Evidence (Special Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 2017.

**2. Interpretation**

In this Act, the “principal Act” means The Evidence (Special Provisions) Act 2009, No. 5 of 2009

**3. Amendment of section 57 of the principal Act**

Section 57 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (9) by inserting after the words “police officer” the words “or an officer of the ONDCP”.

**4. Amendment of section 60 the principal Act**

Section 60 of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2) by inserting after the words “police officer” the words “or an officer of the ONDCP”.
