## FRIENDLY SOCIETIES (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2017

No. 7 of 2017

An Act to amend the Friendly Societies Act, Cap. 184

**Enacted** by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

#### 1. Short Title

This Act may be cited as the Friendly Societies (Amendment) Act, 2017.

## 2. Interpretation

In this Act "principal Act" means the Friendly Societies Act, Cap. 184.

### 3. Amendment of section 4 of the principal Act

5

Section 4 of the principal Act is amended-

- (a) by renumbering the existing provision as subsection (1);
- (b) by adding the words "together with their addresses and occupations" after the word "society" appearing line two of paragraph (1) (b), as renumbered;
- (c) by adding after subsection (1), the following as subsection (2):
- "(2) The Registrar must also forward to the Minister a certified copy of each return sent under section 28; together with such other documentation as may be appropriate in the long term interests and integrity of friendly societies generally."

### 4. Amendment of section 26 of the principal Act

- (1) Section 26 of the principal Act is amended
  - (a) by renumbering the existing provisions as subsection (1);
  - (b) by inserting the words "together with their addresses and occupation" after the word "roll" appearing in line four of subsection (1).
