ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

No. 9 of 2002

AN ACT to amend the Immigration and Passport Act Cap. 208.

[6th June, 2002]

 $\ensuremath{\mathbf{ENACTED}}$ by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows —

1. This Act may be cited as the Immigration and Passport (Amendment) Act 2002.

Short title.

- **2.** The Immigration and Passport Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended in section 14 as follows
 - (a) by the insertion after subsection (7) of the following —

"(8) Subject to section 10, a citizen of a Member State of the Organization of the Eastem Caribbean States landing in Antigua and Barbuda from any place beyond Antigua and Barbuda is entitled to enter and remain in Antigua and Barbuda for a period of six (6) months unless such permit to remain in Antigua and Barbuda is revoked under section 23.

(b) by renumbering subsection (8) as subsection (9).

Amendment of section 15 of Cap. 208.

3. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by the insertion after subsection (4) of the following subsections —

"(5) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a citizen of any Member State of the Organization of the Eastern Caribbean States landing in Antigua and Barbuda from any place beyond Antigua and Barbuda shall be in possession of either a passport or other recognised photo identification card satisfactorily establishing the citizenship and identity of the person to whom it relates.

(6) For the purposes of subsection (5) "other recognised photo identification card" includes a valid Driver's Licence or Social Security card which satisfactorily establishes the citizenship of the person to whom it relates."
