## ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

## No. 9 of 2003

AN ACT to amend the Immigration and Passport ActCap. 208.

## [ 1st September, 2003 ]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows -

1. This Act may be cited as the Immigration and Passport (Amendment) Act, 2003.
2. The Immigration and Passport Act is amended by the insertion after section 20 of the following:-
"Authority of Chief Immigration $\mathrm{O}^{\text {ricer to }}$ regularise residential status. and validation of certain permits.

20A. (1) The Chief Immigration Officer may, in accordance with regulation made under this Act and after obtaining the written approval of the Minister, grant to any person resident in Antigua and Barbuda in contravention of this Act, a permit to remain in Antigua and Barbuda.

The Immigration and Passport
(Amendment)Act, 2003.
(a) in contravention of this Act was at anytime before the commencement of this section resident in Antigua and Barbuda;
(b) is on the commencement of this section resident in Antigua and Barbuda; and
(c) has been granted amnesty or a permit by the chief Immigration Officer to remain in Antigua and Barbuda before the commencement of this section,
shall, for the purposes of this Act and any other law be deemed to have been lawfully resident in Antigua and Barbuda throughout the period of his residence.
