AN ACT to amend the Larceny Act Cap. 241 to increase the penalty for using a firearm to commit certain offences under the Larceny Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Larceny (Amendment) Act, 2017.

2. Interpretation

In this Act “principal Act” means the Larceny Act, Cap. 241.

3. Amendment of section 33A of the principal Act

Section 33A of the principal Act is amended by repealing subsection (1) and substituting the following —

“(1) Every person who, being armed with a firearm commits any of the crimes mentioned under sections 29, 30, 31 or 33 shall be liable on conviction to a term of imprisonment not exceeding thirty-five years.”
