LICENSING (INTOXICATING LIQUOR) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2014

AN ACT to amend the Licensing (Intoxicating Liquor) Act, Cap. 249.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Licensing (Intoxicating Liquor) (Amendment) Act, 2014.

2. Amendment of section 32 – Hours of closing

Section 32 of the Licensing (Intoxicating Liquor) Act, Cap. 249 is amended as follows —

(a) by the repeal of subsection (1) and the substitution of the following —

- (1) Subject as hereinafter provided all licensed premises on which intoxicating liquor are sold, exposed or kept for sale by retail except those premises in respect of which hotel license, a tavern licence or club licence has been granted, shall be closed to the public during the whole of Good Friday.

- (c) in subsection (3) (i), by deleting the words “twelve o’clock midnight” and substituting the words “four o’clock” the following morning.
- (d) by renumbering subsection (4) as subsection (3).
