AN ACT to amend the Medical Benefits Act 1978 (No. 9 of 1978).

[ 24th **November**, 1994. ]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows -

- I. This Act may be cited as the Medical Benefits (Amendment) Short title. Act 1994.
- 2. The Medical Benefits Act, 1978 (No. 9 of 1978) is amended Amendment of in section 3 as follows section 3.
  - by deleting the words "two and one half percent" wherever these occur and substituting the words "three and **one** half percent";
  - by repealing the proviso and substituting the following —

"Provided that —

ANTIGUA **AND BARBUDA**  The Medical Benefits (Amendment) No. 15 of 1994. Act, 1994.

> No contribution shall be payable either by the insured person or his employer in respect of so much of the wages payable to the insured person as exceed the maximum wages upon which contributions are payable under the provisions of the Social Security Act, 1972."
