MONEY LAUNDERING (PREVENTION) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2013

No. 16 of 2013

AN ACT to amend the Money Laundering (Prevention) Act No. 9 of 1996.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Money Laundering (Prevention) (Amendment) Act 2013.

2. Interpretation

In this Act:

“principal Act” means the the Money Laundering (Prevention) Act No. 9 of 1996.

3. Amendment of section 2 of principal Act

Section 2(1) of the principal Act is amended by inserting into the definition of the term “money laundering offence”, immediately after paragraph (d), the following new paragraph as follows-

“(e) section 3 of the Maritime Piracy Act 2013.”.
