AN ACT to amend the Money Laundering Prevention Act, 1996.

[5th February, 2004]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows—

- **1.** This Act may be cited as the Money Laundering Prevention (Amendment) Act, 2003.
- 2. The Money Laundering Prevention Act 1996 is amended by the repeal of subsection 12(1) and the substitution of the following —

 Amendment of section 12.

"(1) A financial institution shall, subject to section 12A, retain, or retain a copy of, each customer generated financial transaction document for the minimum retention period applicable to the document."
