AN ACT to amend the Maritime Piracy Act (2013) No.17 of 2013.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows—

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Maritime Piracy (Amendment) Act 2014.

2. Interpretation

In this Act—

“principal Act” means the Maritime Piracy Act (2013) No.17 of 2013.

3. Amendment of Section 3- Crime of Piracy

The principal Act is amended in section 3 by inserting after the words “Antigua and Barbuda” the following words “or on the high seas”.
