ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

AN ACT to amend the Prison Act Cap. 341.

[1st October, 1998]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Prison (Amendment) Act, 1998.

Short title.

2. Section 2 of the Prison Act, in this Act referred to as the **principal** Act, **is amended** by inserting the following in their alphabetical order:

Insertion of definitions Cap.

"Contracted out prison" means a prison in respect of which there is in force for the time being a contract for the management of the prison;

"the Contractor" means the person who has been contracted to manage the prison;

"Minister" means the Minister with responsibility for the prison;

"prison custody officer" means a person appointed under section 7A;".

AND BARBUDA

Insertion of section 3A.

3. After section 3 of the principal Act the following section is inserted:

"3A(1) The Governor-General on the advice of the Minister may enter into a contract with another person for the management by that person of the prison.

(2) Where the Governor-General has entered into a contract **as** provided under subsection(1) the prison shall be managed subject to and in accordance with the provisions of **the Prison** Act and its Rules."

Insertion of section 7A.

4. After section 7 of the principal Act the following section is inserted:

"7A. Where the Governor-General has entered into a contract **as** provided under section 3A(1), the Governor-General on the advice of the Minister shall

- (a) appoint a superintendent to the contracted out prison to perform the functions of the superintendent under the Prison Act and its Rules;
- (b) appoint prison custody officers to the contracted out prison to carry out the duties and responsibilities of prison officers under the provision of the Prison Act and its Rules.".
