AN ACT to amend the Proceeds of Crime Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Proceeds of Crime (Amendment) Act, 2008.

2. Amendment of section 3 Interpretation

Section 3 of the Proceeds of Crime Act No.13 of 1993, is amended by—

(a) inserting after the definition of “interest” the following—

““person” means any entity, natural or juridical, a corporation, partnership, trust or estate, joint stock company, association, syndicate, joint venture, or other unincorporated organisation or group, capable of acquiring rights or entering into obligations;”.

(b) repealing the definition of “property” and substituting the following—

““property” means assets of every kind, whether corporeal or incorporeal, moveable or

immoveable, tangible or intangible, and legal documents or instruments evidencing title to, or interest in, such assets;”.
