(2) Nothing done or omitted to be done by Colvin Sobers in the performance or purported performance of his functions as Revising Officer for the Constituencies as defined in the Constituencies Boundaries Commission Order, 1984 for the year 1984 shall be or be deemed to be invalid by reason only that Colvin Sobers had not prior to the coming into force of this Act been appointed as Revising Officer for these Constituencies in 1984 under section 7(2) of the Representation of the People Act.
