**REVENUE RECOVERY CHARGE (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2021**

**No. 2 of 2021**

**AN ACT** to amend the Revenue Recovery Charge Act 2010, No. 8 of 2010 and for other connected purposes.

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows -

**1. Short title and commencement**

(1) This Act may be cited as the Revenue Recovery Charge (Amendment) Act, 2021.

(2) The provisions of this Act shall come into effect from the 1<sup>st</sup> March 2021.

**2. Interpretation**

In this Act, “principal Act” means the Revenue Recovery Charge Act 2010, No. 8 of 2010

**3. Amendment of section 11 – Exemptions from the charge**

Section 11 of the principal Act is amended –

(a) by repealing subsection (2) thereof and substituting it with the following:

“(2) The Minister may by Order exempt a person from payment of up to 50% of the charge.”

(b) by inserting the following new subsection immediately after subsection (2) –

“(3) A person shall not be granted an exemption which is greater than 50% of the charge”
