No. 4 of 1995

An Act to provide Supplementary Appropriation for the services of Antigua and Barbuda for the year 1994.

[27th July, 1995]

Enacted by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1994) Act, 1995. Short title

2. The sums set forth in the Schedule amounting to the sum of nine million, two hundred and twenty-three thousand, nine hundred and eleven dollars (\$9,223,911.00) which sums have been drawn from the Consolidated Fund and have been paid for the services of Antigua and Barbuda during the year 1994 in addition to the sums granted by the Appropriation Act, 1994 are declared to have been lawfully paid and appropriated out of the Consolidated Fund for the services mentioned in the Schedule.
