ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

No. 4 of 1996

AN ACT to provide Supplementary Appropriation for the services of Antigua and Barbuda for the year 1995.

[19th December, 1996]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation (1995) Act, 1996.* Short title.

2. The sum set forth in the Schedule amounting to the sum of fourteen million, five hundred and twenty-four thousand, two hundred and fifty-five dollars (\$14,524,255) which sums have been drawn from the Consolidated Fund and have been paid for the services of Antigua and Barbuda during the year 1995 in addition to the sums granted by the Appropriation Act, 1995 are Supplementary Appropriation.
