In exercise of the power conferred under section 12(1) of the Supreme Court Order, Cap. 422A, the Chief Justice with the concurrence of the Prime Ministers, Premiers and Chief Minister of all the States and Territories, the Judical and Legal Services Commission makes the Order:

1. Citation and commencement

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court (Amendment) Order, 2020.
- (2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of September, 2019.

2. Interpretation

In this Order "the principal Order" means The Supreme Court Order, Cap 422A of the Revised Laws of Antigua and Barbuda 1992.

3. Amendment of section 4

Section 4 of the principal order is amended by substituting the word "twelve" for the word "six" appearing in subsection (3).

4. Amendment of Schedule 3

The principal order is amended by deleting Schedule 3 and substituting the following –
