WHEREAS the officers named in the Schedule to this Act were employed at Government House as personal attendants of the Governor of Antigua and the other Presidencies of the Leeward Islands Colony before they were placed on the pensionable establishment of that Colony:

AND WHEREAS the Government of Antigua has agreed that it is just and expedient to make provisions for the payment by the Government of Antigua of a pension in respect of the period during which they served the Governor of Antigua and the other Presidencies of the Leeward Islands as aforesaid.

Bachelor Pensions***

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *St. Clair Simmonds and Solomon Bachelor Pensions Act*.

Reckoning of pensionable service of certain specified officers.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Pensions Act, as from time to time amended and in the Pensions Regulations contained in the First Schedule to the said Act, it shall be lawful to reckon service by each of the officers named in the first column of the Schedule to this Act during the period mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule, as a member of the staff employed at the Governor's Residence (formerly Government House) as being service in a pensionable office for the purpose of computing the pension that may be granted to the said officers in respect of their service with the Government of Antigua only, but for no other purpose.

SCHEDULE

Name of officer	Period of Service
ST. CLAIR SIMMONDS	1st November, 1930 to 31st December, 1943.
SOLOMON BACHELOR	11th September, 1936 to 24th June, 1950.
