WHEREAS it is provided by section 18(1) of the Representation of the People Act that on the coming into force of that Act, the Governor-General acting on the advice of the Electoral Commission shall, by Proclamation, specify a period within which every person who is qualified under section 16 of the Act shall apply to be registered as an elector;

NOW, THEREFORE, I JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, acting on the advice of the Electoral Commission, do hereby specify the period commencing on 1st July and ending on 31st July, 2003 to be the period within which every person who is qualified under section 16 of the Representation of the People Act shall apply to be registered as an elector.
