**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Mushrooms) Order 2001
made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act,
Cap. 410.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Mushrooms) Order 2001. Short title.
2. Special Stamp of the value and description specified in the Schedule are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamp.
Schedule.
3. The special Stamp authorised by this Order shall be released on sale at the General Post Office on the 26th March, 2001 and remain on sale until 25th June, 2001 or until stocks are exhausted, whichever date is sooner. Duration.
4. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 26th March, 2001. Commencement.
