The Antigua and Barbuda Citizenship (Amendment) Regulations 2004 made by the Minister under section 15 of the Antigua and Barbuda Citizenship Act, Cap. 22.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Antigua and Barbuda Citizenship (Amendment) Regulations, 2004. Short title.

2. The Fifth Schedule to the principal Act is repealed and substituted by the following: Repeal and replacement of the Fifth Schedule to the principal Act.
