THE ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA LABOUR CODE (NON APPLICATION OF DIVISION F) (CARICOM) ORDER, made in exercise of the powers contained in Division F 3 (h) of the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code Cap. 27 as amended.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code (Non Application of Division F) (CARICOM) Order, 2014.

2. Non application of Division F to Citizens of Member States of the Caribbean Community

The Provisions of Division F of the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code, with the exception of Division F 5, shall not apply to Citizens of Member States of the Caribbean Community where—

- (a) a work permit application is presented between June 23rd, 2014 and December 31st, 2014, for the grant of a new work permit or for the renewal of a work permit;
- (b) a bill is issued for the payment of work permit fees for the period between June 23rd, 2014 and December 31st, 2014.
