THE ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA LABOUR CODE (NON APPLICATION OF DIVISION F) ORDER made in exercise of the powers contained in Division F 3 (*h*) of the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code Cap. 27 as amended.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code (Non Application of Division F) Order, 2023.

2. Non application of Division F to several classes of persons

The Provisions of Division F of the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code shall not apply to the persons listed in Schedule I.

3. Certificate of exemption from the requirements of a Work Permit

A non citizen of Antigua and Barbuda who is a person to whom Division F does not apply pursuant to Schedule I, shall have an exemption, by virtue of a Certificate (set out in Schedule II) issued by the Labour Commissioner.

SCHEDULE I

Persons to whom Division F does not apply

A National of Bangladesh, Cameroon, Ghana, Kenya, Nigeria and Sierra Leone who travelled to Antigua between 1st November and 29th December, 2022.
