THE ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA LABOUR CODE (NON APPLICATION OF WORK PERMIT FEES) (CARICOM AND DOMINICAN REPUBLIC) ORDER made in exercise of the powers contained in Division F 10 of the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code Cap 27. as amended.

1. Short title and commencement

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code (Non Application of Work Permit Fees) (CARICOM and Dominican Republic) Order, 2023.
 - 2. This Order shall come into force from the 1st day of January, 2023.

2. Elimination of Work Permit fees to several classes of persons

- 1. The Minister, in accordance with the provisions of Division F 10 of the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code, hereby orders that the payment of Work Permit fees shall not apply to the class of persons listed in the Schedules.
- 2. The class of persons listed in the Schedules shall submit an application for a Work Permit in accordance with Division F and pay the applicable application fee.

SCHEDULE 1

Persons to whom elimination of Work Permit fees apply

- A National of the Caribbean Community (CARICOM), who was engaged in employment in Antigua and Barbuda prior to January 1st, 2023.
- B A National of the Dominican Republic who was engaged in employment in Antigua and Barbuda prior to January 1st, 2023.
