THE ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA LABOUR CODE (EXEMPTION OF AIR TRANSPORT INDUSTRY) ORDER made by the Minister in exercise of the powers contained in section C 14(2) of the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code Cap. 27.

1. Short Title

This Order may be cited as the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code (Exemption of Air Transport Industry) Order, 2009.

2. Exemption of Air Transport Industry

The provisions of section C 14 (1) of the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code, shall not apply to airline pilots, flight attendants and the management staff employed in Antigua and Barbuda in the air transport industry.

3. Wages payable

All airline pilots, flight attendants and the management staff employed in Antigua and Barbuda in the air transport industry who are required to work on a public holiday shall be paid in accordance with the provisions of section C 15 (2) of the Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code.

4. Revocation of S.I. 37 of 1989

The Antigua and Barbuda Labour Code (Exemption of Air Transport Industry) Order, Statutory Instrument number 37 of 1989 is hereby revoked.
