The Business Licence Regulations, 1994, made by the Minister under section 22 of the Business Licence Act, 1994 (No. 17 of 1994).

| 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Business Licence Regulations, 1994. | Short title. |
| 2. The forms and certificate of Licence specified in the Schedule are prescribed for the purposes of the Business Licence Act, 1994. | Prescribed forms and Certificate. |
| 3. (1) Every application for a licence to carry on business shall apply to the Minister in the forms prescribed in the Schedule. | Application to carry on business. |
| (2) An applicant who qualifies under the Business Licence Act, 1994 as Antiguan and Barbudan shall complete only Form A. | |
| (3) An applicant who does not qualify under the Business Licence Act, 1994 as Antiguan and Barbudan shall complete both Forms A and B. | |
| 4. (1) Every application for the renewal of a licence shall complete Form A or Forms A and B as the case may be. | Renewal of licence. |
| (2) The application for renewal shall be accompanied by the following— | |
| (a) a certificate of good standing issued by the Director of Social Security Board; | |
| (b) a certificate of good standing issued by the Superintendent of the Medical Benefit Scheme; | |
| (3) Where the Managing Director or officer or person in charge of business is required by law to collect moneys on behalf of the Government, a certificate issued by the Commissioner that all moneys collected prior to the application for renewal has been paid to the Government. | |

Issue of Licence.

5. Where an application is approved by the minister, the applicant shall, upon payment of the prescribed fee to the Commissioner of Inland Revenue be issued with the Certificate of Licence.

Condition of
licence.

6. (1) It is a condition of every licence issued by the Minister under the Business Licence Act, 1994 that the licence is not transferrable and its use is limited only to the type of business applied for.

(2) The Minister may cancel the Certificate of Licence of any person who acts contrary to this regulation.
