COMPANIES ACT (PART III, DIVISION B, EXEMPTION) ORDER, 2017 made by the Minister in exercise of the powers contained in section 339 of the Companies Act 1995, No. 18 of 1995.

1. Short Title

This Order may be cited as the Companies Act (Part III, Division B, Exemption) Order, 2017.

2. Exemption from registration as external company

The Minister of Legal Affairs, in exercise of the powers contained in section 339 of the Companies Act, 1995, hereby exempts 23RD METALLURGICAL CONSTRUCTION GROUP CO. LTD. of the People's Republic of China from the provisions of Part III, Division B of the Companies Act, 1995.

3. Restriction of business activities in Antigua and Barbuda

The 23RD METALLURGICAL CONSTRUCTION GROUP CO. LTD. of the People's Republic of China is, by this Order, permitted to carry on the business activities set out in the Implementation Agreement for the Grant Assistance Project of Antigua and Barbuda Grays Green Community Complex Building, signed on the 27th of April, 2016 between the Government of Antigua and Barbuda and the Government of the People's Republic of China.

4. Registration information of exempted entity

The 23rd Metallurgical Construction Group Co. Ltd. of Minmetals is a company incorporated on 27th May, 1991 in the Hunan Province of the People's Republic of China under the Registered Authority of the Hunan Administration for industry and commerce.
