THE CUSTOMS (CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT) (EXEMPTION) ORDER made in exercise of the powers contained in section 76 of the Customs (Control and Management) Act, 1993 – Act No. 7 of 1993.

1. Short title

(a)

This Order may be cited as the Customs (Control and Management) (Exemption) Order, 2007.

2. Exemption from duties

foodstuffs:

(1) One or more of the following items, not being merchandise for sale and being for personal use, imported by an individual between 15th November, 2007 and 31st December, 2007 are hereby exempted from duties:

(b)	clothing, not exceeding seven pieces of the same type of clothing;

(c)	toilet paper	4818.10
(d)	tooth paste	3306.101
(e)	deodorant	3307.20
0	soap	3401.11 - 3401.91
(g)	shampoo	3305.10

(2) The exemption granted under subparagraph (1) is limited to a maximum of one standard-size shipping barrel for each household and shall not apply where the barrel also contains any items other than those specified in subparagraph (1).

3. Commencement

This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 15th November, 2007.
