THE CUSTOMS APPOINTMENT OF CUSTOMS PORTS (FALMOUTH HARBOUR) ORDER made in exercise of the powers contained in section 12 of the Customs (Control and Management) Act, 1993.

1. Short Title.

This Order may be cited as the Customs appointment of Customs Ports (Falmouth Harbour) Order, 2009.

2. Interpretation

In this Order "Falmouth Harbour" means all waters north of an imaginary straight line running west-ward connecting Blacks Point to Proctors Point and the coastline running north from Proctors Point all the way around and connecting Blacks Point.

3. Appointment of customs port

The port of Falmouth Harbour is hereby appointed a customs port for the entry of cruise ships, yachts and other pleasure vessels.
