The Constituencies Boundaries Commission Order 2003 made by the Governor-General under section 63 of the Constitution.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 63(1) of the Constitution that a Constituencies Boundaries Commission for Antigua and Barbuda shall be appointed from time to time to review the number and the boundaries of the constituencies and to report thereon to the Speaker; and

WHEREAS under section 63 of the Constitution His Excellency the Governor-General on the 4th day of October, 2002 appointed a Constituencies Boundaries Commission (hereinafter referred to as the Commission) to review the number and boundaries of the constituencies and to report thereon to the Speaker; and

WHEREAS in accordance with section 64(2) of the Constitution, the Commission on the 30th day of June, 2003 submitted its report to the Speaker and therein recommended that there be no changes in any of the Constituencies; and

WHEREAS the Prime Minister, in accordance with the provisions of section 65(1) of the Constitution on the 1st day of July, 2003, laid before the House for its approval the draft of an Order giving effect, without modifications, to the recommendations contained in the report and that draft Order was approved by resolution of the House on the same day; and

WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of section 65(4) of the Constitution, the Draft Order laid before the House and approved by Resolution of the House was submitted to the Governor-General by the Prime Minister; and

NOW THEREFORE I, JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda do hereby make an Order in terms of the draft as follows:

Short title.

1. This Order may be cited as the Constituencies Boundaries Order, 2003.

Constituencies.

2. Antigua and Barbuda is divided into seventeen (17) Constituencies, the boundaries whereof are the same as those as are defined in the Schedule to the Constituencies Boundaries Commission Order 1984 (S.I. 1984 No. 4).

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into force upon the next dissolution of Parliament after it is made.
