THE CUSTOMS (DUTY FREE SHOPPING) (DECLARATION OF APPROVED PREMISES) ORDER made in exercise of the powers contained in section 3 of the Customs (Duty Free Shopping) Act, Cap 127.

#### 1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Customs (Duty Free Shopping) (Declaration of Approved Premises) Order, 2017.

### 2. Declaration of approved premises

The Arrival Concourse at the V.C. Bird International Airport is declared as approved premises for the purpose of establishing duty-free boutiques, jewellery shops and other souvenir shops that the Comptroller may approve from time to time.
