## STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

The Chief Justice and two other judges of the Supreme Court, being the authority empowered by section 17 of the West Indies Associated States Supreme Court Order 1967 to make rules regulating the practice and procedure of the Court of Appeal and the High Court have made the following rules —

1. These rules may be cited as the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court Civil Procedure Rules 2000. Citation.
2. The Rules in the Schedule hereto are the rules governing civil procedure in the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court. Rules in the Schedule.
3. It shall not be necessary to include the Schedule to these rules in the annual volume of the Laws of a Member State or Territory of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court, but a reference may be made thereto in such volume and shall be sufficient. Reference to Rules.
4. The Rules of the Supreme Court (Revision) 1970 are repealed, subject to the transitional provisions contained in Part 73 of the Schedule hereto. Repeal.
5. These Rules are deemed to have come into effect in each of the Member States and Territories of the Eastern Caribbean Supreme Court on 31st December, 2000. Commencement.
