THE CUSTOMS (APPOINTMENT OF CUSTOMS PORTS) (CRABBS PENINSULAR) ORDER, made by the Minister in exercise of the powers under section 12 of the Customs (Control and Management) Act, 2013 Act No. 3 of 2013.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Customs (Appointment of Customs Ports) (Crabbs Peninsular) Order, 2020.

2. Appointment of customs port

The Minister of Finance, in exercise of powers granted to him pursuant to Section 12(1) of the Customs (Control and Management) Act, 2013, has appointed the Crabbs Peninsula, situated within Parham in the parish St. Peters, Antigua, as a Customs Port. The Customs Port, with offices located at Northsound Marina and Parham Fisheries Complex in addition to the buildings and structures thereon, includes but is not limited to associated driveways, parking areas and all access ways, attendant infrastructure, future contiguous expansions etc., for all intent and purpose of the provisions contained in the Customs (Control and Management) Act, 2013, No.3 of 2013 as amended.
