**DECLARATION** dated the 29th day of January 2002, made by the Secretary to the Cabinet under section 3 of the Land Acquisition Act Cap. 233, for the acquisition of certain parcels of land in the Parish of St. Phillips and described in the Schedule hereto and in the Land Register for a public purpose.

**IT IS HEREBY DECLARED** that the Cabinet considers that the parcels of land described in the Schedule hereto be acquired for a public purpose, namely to create a fresh environment for investment in the defunct hotel business at Half Moon Bay, to facilitate the revival of the tourist industry and to provide opportunity for the creation of jobs for the inhabitants of Half Moon Bay and the surrounding villages.
