1995, No. 33

Emergency Powers (Fixing Maximum Wholesale and Retail Prices) Order, made by the Cabinet under section 3 of the Emergency Powers, (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act, (Cap. 307).

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Fixing Maximum Retail Prices) Order, 1995. Short title.

2. No person shall sell by retail any of the articles in the Schedule at a price more than the controlled price at which that article was sold on the 3rd September, 1995. Maximum retail price.

4. Any person who contravenes section 1 or section 2 is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of three thousand dollars or to imprisonment for six months. Penalty.
