Emergency Powers (Imposition of Curfew) (City of St. John's) Order, made by the Cabinet under Section 3 of the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act, Cap. 307.

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Imposition of Curfew) (City of St. John's) Order, 1995. Short title.
2. The Cabinet in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Section 3 of the Emergency Powers, (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act, Cap. 307 hereby imposes by this Order a curfew within the City of St. John's. Imposition of Curfew
3. The Curfew imposed by this Order shall be in operation from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. and during the period of the Curfew no person, except those specially authorised to do so, shall be on any street or road or other public place within the City of St. John's. Time of Curfew.
4. For the purposes of this Order the City of St. John's means the area bounded — Interpretation.
- (a) on the South by Vivian Richards Street, New Road and Perry Bay Street;
 - (b) on the East by Independence Avenue, and Cross Street;
 - (c) on the North by Newgate Street to Deepwater Harbour; and
 - (d) on the West by the sea.
5. Any person who contravenes this Order is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of three thousand dollars and to imprisonment for six months. Penalty.
