## 1995, No. 32

Emergency Powers (Requisition of Transport) Order, made by the Cabinet under section 3 of the Emergency Powers, Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act, Cap. 307.

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Requisition of Transport) Order, 1995.

Short title.

2. (1) The owners or persons in charge of any public service vehicles licensed to operate within Antigua and Barbuda shall forthwith report at the nearest Police Station for instructions.

Requisition of public service vehicles.

- (2) The owner of any public service vehicle who fails to report in pursuance of subsection (1) is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of three thousand dollars or to imprisonment for six months.
- 3. Any member of the Defence Force, Police Force or any other person authorised in writing by the Commander of the Defence Force or the Commissioner of Police may enter the premises of any person and requisition any vehicle found on such premises for the purposes of carrying out duties and assignment related to the declaration of a state of emergency.

Members of the Defence Force, Police Force or other persons to enter premises.
