made in exercise of the powers contained in section 4(2) of the Essential Services Act, 2008.**

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Essential Services (No Major Dispute) (Port Authority) Order, 2020.

2. Order of no major dispute

In exercise of the authority granted to me under section 4(2) of the Essential Services Act, 2008 I Steadroy C.O. Benjamin, Attorney General and Minister with responsibility for Labour, in my discretion and having had discussions with the Antigua and Barbuda Workers Union, representing some dissatisfied workers at the Port Authority, hereby Order that the particular trade dispute involving the workers at the Port Authority is not a major dispute.
