THE FINANCIAL SERVICES REGULATORY COMMISSION (AMENDMENT OF DEFINITION OF REGULATORY LAW) REGULATIONS, 2013

WHEREAS by section 2 of the Financial Services Regulatory Commission Act, 2013, the Minister is authorised to prescribe a law for inclusion as part of the definition for regulatory law; and

WHEREAS The Minister in compliance with section 2 of the Financial Services Regulatory Commission Act, 2013, has prescribed that the International Business Corporations Act Cap. 222 shall be included in the definition of regulatory law:

NOW THEREFORE the Minister has prescribed as follows:

1. Short title

These Regulations may be cited as the Financial Services Regulatory Commission (Amendment of definition of regulatory law) Regulations, 2013.

2. Amendment of definition of regulatory law.

The International Business Corporations Act, Cap 222 as amended from time to time and all Regulations, Guidelines and Guidance Notes Made under the Act are hereby prescribed as “regulatory law” for the purpose of the definition in section 2.
