**The Immigration and Passport (Visa Exemption) Order, 2005,
made by the Governor-General under section 15(2) of the
Immigration and Passport Act Cap. 208.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration and Passport (Visa Exemption) Order, 2005.

Short title.

2. (1) Subject to subparagraph (2), any person who is a citizen of the Republic of Cuba landing in Antigua and Barbuda from any place beyond Antigua and Barbuda and in possession of a valid passport issued to him by the proper authority of Cuba is exempt from the provision of section 15(1)(c) of the Immigration and Passport Act Cap. 208 (requiring passport of aliens to be visaed by a consular agent or consular officer in the service of the Government of Antigua and Barbuda or other person duly authorized):

Exemption
of Visa
requirement.

Provided that such citizens do not remain in Antigua and Barbuda for more than thirty (30) days.

(2) The exemption granted under subparagraph (1) does not apply to any Cuban citizen —

- (a) seeking employment or permanent residence; or
- (b) practicing a profession or engaging in trade or business; or
- (c) engaging in public entertainment (including sports) for remunerative purposes, exceeding a period of stay beyond thirty (30) consecutive days.
