**THE IMMIGRATION AND PASSPORT (VISA EXEMPTION) ORDER made by the Minister in exercise of the powers contained in section 11(6) of the Immigration and Passport Act, 2014, No 6 of 2014.**

**1. Short title**

This Order may be cited as the Immigration and Passport (Visa Exemption) Order, 2016.

**2. Exemption of Visa requirement**

(1) A person who is a citizen of a country listed in the Schedule and in possession of a valid passport issued to him by the proper authority shall not be accepted to enter Antigua and Barbuda without having in his passport a valid visa.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), a person, who is a citizen of a country listed in the Schedule and is in possession of a passport issued by the proper authority, may enter Antigua and Barbuda without his passport bearing a valid visa to enter Antigua and Barbuda.
