THE IMMIGRATION AND PASSPORT (PORT OF ENTRY) (BARBUDA) REGULATIONS made in exercise of the powers contained in section 79 of the Immigration and Passport Act, 2014

1. Short title

These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration and Passport (Port of Entry) (Barbuda) Regulations, 2016.

2. Interpretation

In these Regulations “River Dock” means that strip of land located on the South Coast on the island of Barbuda, extending outward into the body of the water which connects Coco Points and Palmetto Point.

3. Designation of Port of Entry

The Minister of Immigration, in exercise of powers granted to him pursuant to Section 79(1) (c) of the Immigration and Passport Act, 2014, hereby designates River Dock a port of entry.
