The Judicial and Legal Services Commission by virtue and exercise of the powers vested in it under section 11 (1) of the Supreme Court Order Cap. 422A and with the concurrence of the Prime Ministers and Premiers of all the States, hereby orders and determines as follows —

1. This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court (Salaries, Allowances and Conditions of Service of Judges) Order 1996. Short title.

2. The Salaries specified in Schedule 3 of the Supreme Court Order Cap. 422A are altered by the deletion of the salaries appearing therein and the substitution therefor of the salaries specified in the Schedule below. Alteration of salaries in Schedule Cap. 422A. Order.
