1. Short Title

This Order may be cited as the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters (Designation of a Central Authority) Order 2023.

2. Designation of a Central Authority

For the purposes of the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1993, Maureen Payne-Hyman is, by this Order, designated the Central Authority for Antigua and Barbuda in any matter involving Cosbert Sargeant, Arleigh Byer and Jamal Kane.

3. Commencement

This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 1st of August 2023.
